Unified Work Programs

c. UWP Revisions

The UWP may be revised any time during the program period. <u>Major revisions will follow</u> <u>the procedures outlined in paragraphs 3, 4a</u> <u>and 4b</u>. Minor revisions may be accomplished simply by the modal administration involved. <u>A minor revision is:</u>

(1) The addition of (or a change in) a work element/task which will be (or was) funded by only one administration/agency (EPA, FAA, FRA, FHWA, UMTA, HUD, etc.); and the funding involved does not exceed 10 percent of the total funds originally approved for the entire UWP.
