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# **DEFINITIONS**

# REPORTABLE TRAFFIC CRASH

A reportable traffic crash is one which results in bodily injury to or death of any person or total property damage of \$1000.00 or more.

# **CRASH SEVERITY**

Fatal Crash A traffic crash involving one or more persons

killed.

Injury Crash A traffic crash involving one or more persons

who were injured and no fatalities.

Property Damage Only (PDO) A traffic crash involving property damage of

\$1000.00 or more and no injuries or fatalities.

# **INJURY STATUS**

Fatal Injury Any injury resulting in death within 30 days after the

traffic crash.

Incapacitating Injury Any injury, other than a fatal injury, which prevents the

injured person from walking, driving or normally continuing any activities the person was capable of

performing before the injury occurred.

Non-Incapacitating Injury Any injury, other than a fatal or incapacitating injury,

which is evident to observers at the scene of the traffic

crash.

Possible Injury No evidence of an injury, but complaint of pain.












