CIRCULAR MEMORANDUM TO: Regional and Division Engineers

SUBJECT: Joint Development Concept - Speech by Mr. Frank Turner

At the recent AASHO meeting in Wichita, Kansas, both Under Secretary Boyd and I paid particular attention to the increasing need to find better solutions to our urban transportation problems. We both urged that State and Bureau officials give special consideration to the utilization of the joint development concept wherever it might be applicable in urban areas where new freeway construction is planned.

The most thorough examination of this concept on the complementary development of urban freeways and other community facilities was presented at AASHO by Chief Engineer Frank Turner. Mr. Turner's talk delves into the practical application of the concept and discusses the questions most likely to appear in actual application.

I believe Mr. Turner's discussion will prove most useful to those concerned with implementing this concept, and I am transmitting it for their attention.
