STATE-OWNED RAIL MILEAGE

The state of Michigan owns 695 miles of rail line for operation and railbanks. The state contracts with operators to provide service on selected lines. When a railway is

railbanked, it means that service is not currently needed but it is preserved by the state for future use. In 2001, all 695 miles were in operation and none were railbanked.
