



All vehicle travel on all interstate highways for Week 16, starting Monday, April 13, 2020, ending Sunday, April 19, 2020, decreased 45% (7.4 billion vehicle miles) as compared with the same week of 2019. Travel for the week is estimated to be 9.1 billion vehicle miles.



Passenger vehicle travel on all interstate highways for Week 16, starting Monday, April 13, 2020, ending Sunday, April 19, 2020, decreased 51% as compared with the same week of 2019.

Truck travel on all interstate highways for Week 16, starting Monday, April 13, 2020, ending Sunday, April 19, 2020, decreased 16% as compared with the same week of 2019.
