Criminal Penalties

The purpose of this amendment is to enlarge the scope of § 408.27 by adding new paragraph (d), which refers to the additional criminal penalties provided by section 1203 of the Federal Aviation Act of 1958, and also to make a minor editorial change. Since this amendment is not a substantive rule but one of Agency procedure, notice and public procedure hereon are unnecessary.

In consideration of the foregoing, and in accordance with section 3 of the Administrative Procedure Act, I hereby amend Part 408 of the Regulations of the Federal Aviation Agency as follows:

1. Delete the last sentence of paragraph (c) of § 408.27.
2. Add new paragraphs (d) and (e) to § 408.27 to read as follows:
 - (d) Under section 1203 of the Act, any person who knowingly or willfully violates any provision of Title XII, or any rule, regulation, or order issued thereunder shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof

shall be subject to a fine or imprisonment, or both.

(e) If it appears from a report received by the Agency that any of these offenses has been committed, the Administrator will, in an appropriate case, send the report to the U.S. Department of Justice for criminal prosecution of the person who committed the offense.

This amendment shall be effective upon the date of its publication in the FEDERAL REGISTER.
