held at its office in Washington, D. C.
on the 15th day of May , 1940

Acting pursuant to the authority vested in it by the
Civil Aeronautics Act of 1938, particularly sections 205(a),
601(a), and 602 of said Act, and finding that its action is
desirable in the public interest and is necessary to carry
out the provisions of and to exercise and perform its powers
and duties under said Act, the Civil Aeronautics Authority
hereby amends the Civil Air Regulations as follows:

AMENDMENT NO. 49
OF THE CIVIL AIR
REGULATIONS

AIRLINE TRANSPORT
PILOT PRIVILEGES

Effective May 15, 1940 , Part 21, as amended, of the
Civil Air Regulations is amended as follows:


1. Section 21.350 is amended to read as follows:

"21.350. The holder of a valid airline transport pilot
certificate may pilot an airplane as a second pilot without a
weight and engine classification for the particular airplane
operated."

2. Section 21.351 is amended to read as follows:

"21.351. The holder of a valid airline transport pilot certificate may pilot airplanes of a weight or engine classification, or of an airplane classification other than that specified in his airline transport pilot certificate, but shall not carry any person in such airplanes other than members of the crew thereof, certificated airman carried in air carrier airplanes in furtherance of their official duties, or certificated instructors rated for the airplane operated."
