PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS,
CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Revocation of Control Zone

The purpose of this amendment to § 71.171 of the Federal Aviation Regulations is to revoke the Middleton Island, Alaska, control zone.

Weather reporting service is no longer available at the Middleton Island Airport. Therefore, the Federal Aviation Agency has determined that the Middleton Island control zone is no longer justified as an assignment of controlled airspace and action is taken herein to revoke the Middleton Island control zone.

Since the change effected by this amendment is less restrictive in nature than present requirements, notice and public procedure hereon are unnecessary and it may be made effective immediately.

In consideration of the foregoing, the following action is taken:

In § 71.171 (27 F. R. 220-91, November 10, 1962), the Middleton Island, Alaska, control zone is revoked.

This amendment shall become effective upon the date of publication in the Federal Register.
