PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS, CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Revocation of Control Area Extension and Designation of Transition Area

On March 28, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 3053) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) proposed to revoke the Belleville, Ill., control area extension and designate a transition area at Centralia, Ill.

Interested persons have been afforded an opportunity to participate in the making of the rules herein adopted, and no adverse comments were received regarding the proposed amendments.

Subsequent to the publication of the Notice, it was determined that the coordinates depicting the geographical center of Scott AFB, Belleville, Ill., should be Lat. 38° 32' 30" N, Long. 89° 51' 05" W, rather than Lat. 38° 32' 29" N, Long. 89° 51' 56" W. The action taken herein reflects this change.

The substance of the proposed amendments having been published, and for the reasons stated in the Notice, the following actions are taken:

- Section 71.165 (27 F. R. 220-59, November 10, 1962) is amended by revoking the following:
 Belleville, III.
- 2. In Section 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) the following is added:

Centralia, Ill.

That airspace extending upward from 700 feet above the surface within a 4-mile radius of the Centralia Municipal Airport (Lat. 38° 30' 40" N. Long. 89° 05' 35" W), and within 2 miles each side of the Centralia VOR 0310 radial, extending from the 4-mile radius area to the VOR: within a 4-mile radius of the Mount Vernon, Ill., Municipal Airport (Lat. 380 19' 15" N. Long. 88° 51° 40" W), and within 2 miles each side of the 044° bearing from the airport, extending from the 4-mile radius area to 8 miles NE of the airport; and the airspace extending upward from 1,200 feet above the surface bounded by a line beginning at the N boundary of V-446, extending S along Long. 88° 35' 00" W, to Lat. 38° 12' 00" N, thence W along Lat. 38° 12' 00" N, to and counterclockwise along the arc of a 40-mile radius circle centered at Scott AFB, Belleville, Ill., (Lat. 38° 32' 30" N. Long. 890 51' 05" W) to and clockwise along the arc of a 13-mile radius circle centered on the Centralia VOR to and counterclockwise along the arc of the 40-mile radius circle centered on Scott AFB to the N boundary of V-446, thence E along the N boundary of V-446 to the point of beginning.

These amendments shall become effective 0001 EST, August 22, 1963. (Sec. 307(a), 72 Stat. 749; 49 U. S. C. 1348).
