PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS,  
CONTROLLED AIRSPACE AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Modification of Amendment -  
Change of Effective Date

On February 14, 1963, there was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 1419) an amendment to Part 71 (New) of the Federal Aviation Regulations which altered the Washington, D. C., control zone.

Subsequent to publication of the amendment it was determined that the date for the conversion of the Washington radio range to a radio beacon should be made on March 7, 1963. Therefore, action is taken herein to change the effective date of the rule to March 7, 1963.

Since this amendment imposes no additional burden on any person, notice and public procedure hereon are unnecessary.

In consideration of the foregoing, effective immediately, Airspace Docket No. 62-EA-84 is hereby modified as follows:

"effective 0001 E. S. T. April 4, 1963" is deleted and "effective 0001 E. S. T. March 7, 1963" is substituted therefor.
