Designation of Transition Area

On June 8, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 5651) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to designate a transition area at Lanai, Hawaii.

Interested persons were afforded an opportunity to participate in the rulemaking through submission of comments. Due consideration was given to all relevant matter presented.

The substance of the proposed amendment having been published and for the reasons stated in the Notice, the following action is taken:

§ 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) is amended by adding the following:

Lanai, Hawaii

That airspace extending upward from 700 feet above the surface within a 5-mile radius of Lanai Airport (Lat. 20° 47' 30" N, Long. 156° 57' 00" W).

This amendment shall become effective 0001 EST, December 12, 1963.
