PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS,
CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Alteration and Designation of Transition Area

On August 1, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 7854) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to designate a transition area at Laurel, Miss., and alter the Hattiesburg, Miss., transition area.

Interested persons were afforded an opportunity to participate in the rulemaking through submission of comments. All comments received were favorable.

The substance of the proposed amendments having been published and for the reasons stated in the Notice, § 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) is amended as follows:

1. The following transition area is added:

Laurel, Miss.

That airspace extending upward from 700 feet above the surface within a 5-mile radius of Laurel Municipal Airport (Lat. 31° 40' 10" N, Long. 89° 10' 20" W); within 8 miles SW and 5 miles NE of the Laurel VOR330° radial, extending from the VOR to 12 miles NW.

2. The Hattiesburg, Miss., transition area is amended to read:

Hattiesburg, Miss.

(Airspace Docket No. 63-SO-34)

That airspace extending upward from 700 feet above the surface within a 5-mile radius of the Hattiesburg Municipal Airport (Lat. 31° 16' 00" N, Long. 89° 15' 15" W); within 2 miles each side of the Hattiesburg VOR 154° radial, extending from the 5-mile radius area to the VOR; within 2 miles each side of the 315° bearing from the Hattiesburg Municipal Airport, extending from the 5-mile radius area to 12 miles NW of the airport; and that airspace extending upward from 1,200 feet above the surface within a 20-mile radius of the Hattiesburg VOR; within a 15-mile radius of the Laurel Municipal Airport, Laurel, Miss., (Lat. 31° 40' 10" N, Long. 89° 10' 20" W); and within 5 miles each side of the Laurel VOR 150° radial, extending from the 15-mile and the 20-mile radius areas to 23 miles SE of the VOR, excluding the portion within R-4401.

These amendments shall become effective 0001 EST, December 12, 1963.
