PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS, CONTROLLED AIRSPACE AND REPORTING POINTS

Alteration of Transition Area

On April 9, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 3457) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to amend Part 71 (New) by altering the Matador, Tex., transition area.

Interested persons have been afforded an opportunity to participate in the making of the rule herein adopted and no adverse comments were received.

The substance of the proposed amendment having been published, therefore, and for the reasons stated in the Notice, the following action is taken:

In § 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) the Matador, Tex., transition area is amended to read:

Matador, Tex.

That airspace extending upward from 1,200 feet above the surface within 9 miles NW and 6 miles SE of the Childress, Tex.,

VOR 244° radial, extending from 8 miles SW to 19 miles

NE of the Matador INT (INT of Childress VOR 244° and Guthrie,

(Airspace Docket No. 63-SW-17)

Tex., VOR 293° radials), and within 9 miles SE and 6 miles NW of the Childress VOR 244° radial, extending from 8 miles NE to 19 miles SW of the Matador INT.

This amendment shall become effective 0001 EST, October 17, 1963.
