PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS,
CONTROLLED AIRSPACE AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Designation of Transition Area

On March 2, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 2051) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to designate a transition area at Corona, N. Mex.

Interested persons have been afforded an opportunity to participate in the making of the rule herein adopted, and no adverse comments were received regarding the proposed amendment.

The substance of the proposed amendment having been published, and for the reasons stated in the Notice, the following action is taken:

In § 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) the following is added:

Corona, N. Mex.

That airspace extending upward from 8,500 feet MSL, within 10 miles NE and 7 miles SW of the Corona VOR 139° and 319° radials, extending from 20 miles SE to 9 miles NW of the VOR.

This amendment shall become effective 0001 EST, **September 19, 1963.**
