PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS, CONTROLLED AIRSPACE AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Designation of Transition Area

On March 2, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 2052) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to designate a transition area at Columbus, N. Mex.

Interested persons have been afforded an opportunity to participate in the making of the rule herein adopted, and no adverse comments were received regarding the proposed amendment.

The substance of the proposed amendment having been published, and for the reasons stated in the Notice, the following action is taken:

In § 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) the following is added:

Columbus, N. Mex.

That airspace extending upward from 8,000 feet MSL, bounded on the E by Long.  $107^{\circ}$  13' 00'' W, on the S by the United States/Mexican border, on the W by Long.  $107^{\circ}$  54' 00'' W, and on the N by Lat.  $31^{\circ}$  59' 00'' N.

This amendment shall become effective 0001 EST, August 22, 1963. (Sec. 307(a), 72 Stat. 749; 49 U. S. C. 1348).
