PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS,
CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Alteration of Control Area Extension

The purpose of this amendment to § 71.165 of the Federal Aviation Regulations is to alter the description of the Little Rock, Ark., control area extension.

The Little Rock control area extension is designated, in part, with reference to the Little Rock radio range. The Federal Aviation Agency has converted this facility to a radio beacon. The action taken herein reflects the conversion of this facility. Controlled airspace requirements for the Little Rock terminal area will be reviewed at a later date under the CAR Amendments 60-21/60-29 implementation program.

Since the change effected by this amendment is editorial in nature, notice and public procedure hereon are unnecessary.

In consideration of the foregoing, the following action is taken: § 71.165 (27 F. R. 220-59, November 10, 1962) is amended as follows:

In the Little Rock, Ark., control area extension "Within a 50-mile radius of the Little Rock RR" is deleted and "Within a 50-mile radius of the Little Rock RBN" is substituted therefor.

This amendment shall become effective upon the date of publication in the Federal Register.
