PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS,
CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Revocation of Control Zone

The purpose of this amendment to Part 71 (New) of the Federal Aviation Regulations is to revoke the Lake Charles, La. (Chennault AFB) control zone.

The Department of the Air Force has advised that flight operations at Chennault AFB will be discontinued on April 1, 1963. Therefore, action is taken herein to revoke the Chennault AFB control zone. Controlled airspace requirements for this area will be further reviewed at a later date under the CAR Amendment 60-21/60-29 implementation program.

Since the change effected by this amendment is less restrictive in nature than present requirements, notice and public procedure hereon are unnecessary and it may be made effective April 1, 1963.

In consideration of the foregoing and pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Administrator (25 F. R. 12582), the following action is taken:

In § 71.171 (27 F. R. 220-91, November 10, 1962), the Lake Charles, La. (Chennault AFB), control zone is revoked.

This amendment shall become effective 0001 E. S. T. April 1, 1963.
