PART 71 DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS,
CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Alteration of Federal Airways

The purpose of these amendments to Part 71 (New) of the Federal Aviation Regulations is to alter the descriptions of VOR Federal airway Nos. 15 and 76 between Galveston, Tex., and Houston, Tex., by excluding the airspace within the Houston, Tex., Restricted Area/Military Climb Corridor (R-6310) from the airways. This will permit simultaneous use of altitudes on the airways and the airspace within R-6310.

Since these changes are minor in nature and impose no additional burden on any person, notice and public procedure hereon are unnecessary and they may be made effective immediately.

In consideration of the foregoing, the following actions are taken:

§ 71.123 (27 F. R. 220-6, November 10, 1962, 28 F. R. 2229, 3780) is amended as follows:

In V-15 and V-76 "The airspace within R-6310 shall be used only after obtaining prior approval from the appropriate authority." is deleted and "The airspace within R-6310 is excluded." is substituted therefor.
