## Alteration of Federal Airway

On June 14, 1963, a notice of proposed rule making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 6093) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) proposed to realign intermediate altitude Federal airway V-1730 between Prescott, Ariz., and Russell, Kansas.

Interested persons were afforded an opportunity to participate in the rule making through the submission of comments but no comments were received.

The substance of the proposed amendments having been published, and for the reasons stated in the notice, the following action is taken:

In § 71.143 (27 F. R. 220-38, November 10, 1962) V-1730 is amended to read:

"V-1730 Prescott, Ariz; Winslow, Ariz.; Farmington, N. Mex.; Alamosa, Colo.; Lamar, Colo.; Russell, Kans."

This amendment shall become effective 0001 EST, November 14, 1963. (Sec. 307(a), 72 Stat. 749; 49 U. S. C. 1348).
