PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS, CONTROLLED AIRSPACE AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Alteration of Reporting Point

The purpose of this amendment to § 71.205 of the Federal Aviation Regulations is to delete reference to intermediate altitude Federal airway V-1528 in the designation of the Stockton, Calif., reporting point.

On June 27, 1963, V-1528 was revoked (Airspace Docket No. 62-SW-59, 28 F. R. 4507); however, the Stockton, Calif., is still designated as a reporting point for V-1528. Therefore, action is taken herein to correct the designation of the Stockton, Calif., reporting point.

Since this amendment is editorial in nature, notice and public procedure hereon are unnecessary and it may be made effective immediately.

In consideration of the foregoing, effective immediately, the following action is taken:

In § 71.205 (27 F. R. 220-165 November 10, 1962) "Stockton, Calif.; V-1516, V-1559, V-1528." is deleted and "Stockton, Calif.; V-1516, V-1559." is substituted therefor.
