 PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS
 CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Alteration of Control Zone,
 Revocation of Control Area Extension,
 and Designation of Transition Area

On April 19, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 3872) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) proposed to alter the Yuma, Ariz., control zone, revoke the Yuma control area extension, and designate the Yuma transition area.

Interested persons have been afforded an opportunity to participate in the making of the rules herein adopted, and no adverse comments were received regarding the proposed amendments.

The substance of the proposed amendments having been published, and for the reasons stated in the Notice, the following actions are taken:

1. In Section 71.171 (27 F. R. 220-91, November 10, 1962), the Yuma, Ariz., control zone is amended to read:

Within a 5-mile radius of MCAS/Yuma County Airport (Lat. 32° 39' 10" N, Long. 114° 36' 20" W); within a 1-mile radius of Lat. 32° 36' 05" N, Long. 114° 39' 30" W; within 2 miles each side of the Yuma VOR 181° radial, extending from the 5-mile radius zone to 1 mile S of the VOR, and within 2 miles each side of the 044° bearing from the MCAS Yuma RBN, extending

from the 5-mile radius zone to 8 miles NE of the RBN.

2. Section 71.165 (27 F. R. 220-59, November 10, 1962, 28 F. R. 1794), the following control area extension is revoked:

Yuma, Ariz.

3. Section 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) is amended by adding the following:

Yuma, Ariz.

That airspace extending upward from 700 feet above the surface within an 8-mile radius of MCAS Yuma RBN; and that airspace extending upward from 1,200 feet above the surface within 11 miles E and 8 miles W of the Yuma VOR 351° and 180° radials, extending from 20 miles N to 26 miles S of the VOR, and within 5 miles N and 8 miles S of the Yuma VOR 087° radial, extending from the VOR to 14 miles E of the VOR, excluding the portions within R-2301 and R-2307, and the portion outside the United States.

These amendments shall become effective 0001 EST, August 22, 1963.
