PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS, CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Designation of Transition Area

On May 8, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 4622) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to designate a transition area at Wendover, Utah.

Interested persons have been afforded an opportunity to participate in the making of the rule herein adopted, and no adverse comments were received regarding the proposed amendment.

The substance of the proposed amendment having been published and for the reasons stated in the Notice, the following action is taken:

§ 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) is amended by adding the following:

Wendover, Utah

That airspace extending upward from 8,700 feet MSL bounded on the N by a line 5 miles S of and parallel to the Lucin, Utah, VOR 096° radial, on the W by a line 5 miles E of and parallel to the Lucin VOR 174° radial, on the S by a line 5 miles N of and parallel to the Bonneville, Utah, VOR 084° radial, and on the E by a line beginning at Lat. 40° 51' 30" N, Long. 112° 56' 30" W, to Lat. 41° 00' 00" N, Long. 112° 56' 30" W, to Lat. 41° 00' 00" N, Long. 112° 45' 00" W, to Lat. 41° 10' 40" N, Long. 112° 45' 00" W, to Lat. 41° 12' 00" N, Long. 112° 52' 00" W, thence N via Long. 112° 52' 00" W, to a line 5 miles S of and parallel to the Lucin VOR 096° radial, excluding the portion within the Lucin, Utah, transition area. The portion within R-6404 shall be used only after obtaining prior approval from appropriate authority.
