CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Revocation of Control Area Extension, and Designation of Transition Area

On April 27, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 4205) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to revoke the Blythe, Calif., control area extension and designate the Blythe transition area.

Interested persons have been afforded an opportunity to participate in the making of the rules herein adopted, and no adverse comments were received regarding the proposed amendments.

The substance of the proposed amendments having been published and for reasons stated in the Notice, the following actions are taken:

- § 71.165 (27 F. R. 220-59, November 10, 1962) is amended by revoking the following control area extension:
 Blythe, Calif.
- § 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) is amended by adding the following:
 Blythe, Calif.

(Airspace Docket No. 62-WE-141)

That airspace extending upward from 700 feet above the surface within a 2-mile radius of the Blythe RBN; within 2 miles each side of the 180° bearing from the Blythe RBN, extending from the 2-mile radius area to 8 miles S of the RBN, and within 2 miles each side of the Blythe VORTAC 227° radial, extending from the arc of a 5-mile radius circle centered at the Blythe Airport (Lat. 33° 37' 15" N, Long. 114° 43' 00" W) to 8 miles SW of the VORTAC; and that airspace extending upward from 1,200 feet above the surface bounded on the N by Lat. 33° 43' 00" N, on the E by Long. 114° 30' 00" W, on the S by the arc of an 18-mile radius circle centered at the Blythe Airport, and on the W by Long. 115° 00' 00" W, and within 5 miles each side of the 180° bearing from the Blythe RBN, extending from the 18-mile radius arc to 23 miles S of the RBN.

These amendments shall become effective 0001 EST, October 17, 1963.
