Revocation of Restricted Area

The purpose of this amendment to § 73.34 of the Federal Aviation Regulations is to revoke the Bunker Hill AFB, Ind., Restricted Area/ Military Climb Corridor R-3402.

The Department of the Air Force has advised the Federal Aviation Agency that it no longer has a requirement for R-3402. Therefore, the assignment of this airspace as a restricted area is no longer warranted, and revocation thereof will be in the public interest. Such action is taken herein.

Since this amendment reduces a burden on the public, notice and public procedure and the 30-day notice period prior to effectiveness required by the Administrative Procedure Act are unnecessary.

In consideration of the foregoing, the following action is taken:

In § 73.34 (28 F. R. 19-20, January 26, 1963), R-3402 Bunker Hill, AFB, Ind., Restricted Area/Military Climb Corridor, is revoked.

This amendment shall become effective upon the date of publication in the Federal Register.
