Designation of Restricted Area

On August 2, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 7915) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to designate a restricted area at Sierra Army Depot, Herlong, Calif. This restricted area would protect aircraft from those hazards resulting from uncontrolled explosions which may occur during an ammunition neutralization process known as burning.

Interested persons were afforded an opportunity to participate in the rulemaking through submission of comments but no comments were received.

The substance of the proposed amendment having been published, therefore, for the reasons stated in the Notice, the following action is taken:

In § 73.25 California (28 F. R. 19-8, January 26, 1963), the following is added:

R-2530 Sierra Army Depot, Calif.

Boundaries. Beginning at Lat. 40° 18' 21" N, Long. 120° 05' 06" W; to Lat. 40° 18' 21" N, Long. 120° 02' 51" W; to Lat. 40° 16' 06" N, Long. 120° 02' 51" W; to Lat. 40° 16' 06" N, Long. 120° 05' 06" W; to the point of beginning.

Designated altitudes. Surface to 8,600 feet MSL.

Time of designation. 0800 to 1800 PST, Monday through Friday.

Using agency. Commanding Officer, Sierra Army Depot, Herlong, California.

This amendment shall become effective 0001 EST January 9, 1964.
