AMENDMENT OF PART 42 OF THE CIVIL AIR REGULATIONS - NONSCHEDULED AIR CARRIER CERTIFICATION AND OPERATION RULES

Effective July 15, 1947, Part 42 of the Civil Air Regulations is amended as follows:

1. By adding to paragraph 42.221 (b) a subparagraph (2) to read as follows:

42.221 Aircraft of 10,000 lbs. or more maximum take-off weight. \*

- (b) Second pilot. \* \* \*
  - (2) possess a currently effective instrument rating.
- 2. By amending § 42.23 (b), Instrument flight, to read as follows:
- (b) <u>Instrument competency</u>. A pilot shall not pilot an aircraft under instrument flight rules unless within the preceding 6 calendar months he has demonstrated to the administrator, or his representative, his ability to competently pilot an aircraft in instrument flight under actual or simulated conditions.
