Civil Air Regulations Amendment 20-25

Effective: Jan. 1, 1942

Adopted: Dec. 23, 1941

"20.126 Aeronautical experience. Applicant shall have logged at least 35 hours of solo flight time: Provided, That an applicant seeking a rating limited to two-control non-spinnable airplanes with nose wheel type landing gear shall have logged at least 25 hours of solo flight time. As part of the foregoing applicant shall have logged at least 5 hours within the 60 days immediately preceding the date of filing the application, and at least 5 hours of cross-country flying of which at least 3 hours shall be solo, which shall include at least one flight over a course of not less than 50 miles with at least two full-stop landings at different points along the course. Such experience shall be certified to by some person, other than the applicant, having direct knowledge thereof. A graduate of the private pilot course of a certificated flying school will be deemed to have met the above requirements upon presentation of his certificate of graduation within 30 days thereof.³"
