DURATION OF CERTIFICATES

Effective July 1, 1945, \$20.51 of the Civil Air Regulations, adopted April 26, 1945, is amended to read as follows:

- 20.5; Duration. A student pilot certificate or a pilot certificate with a private or commercial rating shall expire 24 calender months* after the month of issuance. However the Administrator or his authorized representative may issue a temporary pilot certificate with a private or commercial rating for a period of not to exceed 90 days subject to the terms and conditions specified therein by the Administrator.
- * For example, a certificate issued any time in April 1946 will expire on the last day of April 1948.
