AMENDMENT TO PART 60 - AIR TRAFFIC RULES -
OF THE CIVIL AIR REGULATIONS

Effective May 21, 1946, Part 60 of the Civil Air Regulations is
amended by adding a new subsection (d) to § 60.106 to read as follows:

60.106 Operation on and in the vicinity of airports. * * * * *

(d) The Administrator shall coordinate the flight
activities of any airport with the flight activities of any other
airport located within 5 miles in order to avoid conflict in air
traffic resulting from the proximity of such airports.
