AIRCRAFT AIRWORTHINESS CLASSIFICATION SYMBOLS

The provisions of Part 06 relating to airworthiness classification utilize the symbols "C," "R," and "X" to denote the appropriate aircraft airworthiness classification. The purpose of this amendment is to prescribe the use of the terms "standard," "restricted," and "experimental" in lieu of the symbols "C," "R," and "X," respectively. This part will then be consistent with the amendment of Part 43 which prescribes the use of these terms.

Interested persons have been afforded an opportunity to participate in the making of this amendment, and due consideration has been given to all relevant matter presented.

In consideration of the foregoing the Civil Aeronautics Board hereby amends Part 06 of the Civil Air Regulations (14 CFR, Part 06, as amended) effective July 3, 1948:

By amending §§ 06.011, 06.012, and 06.02 by inserting in parentheses as alternate terms the words "standard," "restricted," and "experimental" wherever the symbols "C," "R," and "X," respectively, appear therein.
