SPECIAL CIVIL AIR REGULATION

AUTHORIZATION TO THE ADMINISTRATOR OF CIVIL  
AERONAUTICS TO ISSUE "ASSISTANT AIRLINE TRANSPORT  
PILOT CERTIFICATES" TO A DESIGNATED CLASS OF PILOTS

The following Special Civil Air Regulation is made and promulgated to become effective July 1, 1943.

An airman certificate of assistant airline transport pilot grade may be issued by the Administrator of Civil Aeronautics to pilots listed in the operations specifications of scheduled air carriers engaged in overseas or foreign air transportation: Provided, That such pilots are holders of currently effective commercial pilot certificates with appropriate aircraft and instrument ratings: Provided further, That such certificates shall authorize these pilots to serve as first pilots in scheduled air transportation carrying cargo and mail but shall not authorize them to carry persons for hire in such transportation.

This regulation shall terminate on December 31, 1943.
