
Acting pursuant to the authority vested in it by the

and duties under said Act, the Civil Aeronautics Authority
hereby amends the Civil Air Regulations as follows:

AMENDMENT NO. 15
OF THE CIVIL AIR
REGULATIONS

DESIGNATING A NEW
CONTROL AIRPORT

Section 60.21 of the Civil Air Regulations is hereby
amended by inserting the words "New York, N. Y. -----
New York Municipal Airport", immediately following the words
"New York, N. Y. ----- Floyd Bennett Field".
