Section 406.12a is amended to read:

§ 406.12a *Medical certification of military personnel.* A rated pilot on active duty and on flying status in the Armed Forces, or other military personnel on active duty and performing military air traffic control duties, may be issued a CAA Class II medical certificate for an appropriate airman certificate in accordance with the procedures outlined herein, on the basis of a physical examination performed by a military flight surgeon or aviation medical examiner. The report of medical examination on Standard Form 88 will be forwarded by the examiner to a designated aviation staff medical officer of his respective

service for review and evaluation. If the prescribed medical standards are met, the reviewing officer will endorse the report and prepare and issue to the qualified applicant a CAA Medical Certificate, Form ACA-1004. The endorsed report of medical examination and the carbon copy of the medical certificate issued will be submitted through appropriate channels to the Chief, Medical Division, Civil Aeronautics Administration, Washington 25, D. C., for file.
