ORDER RENUMBERING AMENDMENTS NOS. 60-1 THROUGH 60-5
Adopted between May 11 and June 12, 1942

IT APPEARING THAT:

(a) Section 60.97, entitled "Transportation of explosives", having been recently amended on four different occasions and that it is, therefore, desirable to include these amendments and an additional amendment to section 60.96, relating to weather information, in the reprinting of the new Part 60 which is presently in the form of page proof; and

(b) In order to provide for the inclusion of these amendments in the new printing, it will be necessary to remember such amendments as amendments of the edition of October 4, 1940;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered that amendments Nos. (60-1, 60-2, 60-3, 60-4, and 60-5) of the present reprinting of Part 60 be, and hereby are, renumbered 60-64, 60-65, 60-66, 60-67 and 60-68, respectively, as amendments of the edition of October 4, 1940, and it is further ordered that the present reprinting of Part 60, Air Traffic Rules, be, and hereby is, designated as the edition of July 15, 1942.
