CIVIL AIR REGULATIONS DRAFT RELEASE NO. 61-9A

SUBJECT: Regulation of Aircraft Speed

Civil Air Regulations Draft Release No. 61-9 published in the Federal Register on May 9, 1961 (26 F.R. 4001), stated that consideration would be given to all comments received prior to July 10, 1961.

Draft Release 61-9 proposed that arriving aircraft reduce speed within 50 nautical miles of the airport and during flight below 14,500 feet m.s.l.

Representatives of the aviation industry have requested additional time for study and evaluation of the proposed amendment. Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Administrator (14 CFR Part 405), notice is hereby given that the time within which comments on Civil Air Regulations Draft Release 61-9 will be received is extended to August 1, 1961. Communications should be submitted in duplicate to the Docket Section of the Federal Aviation Agency, Room B-316, 1711 New York Avenue, N. W., Washington 25, D. C. All comments submitted will be available for examination by interested persons in the Docket Section when the prescribed date for return of comments has expired.
