PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS,
CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Designation of Transition Area

On May 16, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 4919) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to designate a transition area at Minneapolis, Minn.

Interested persons were afforded an opportunity to participate in the rulemaking through submission of comments. All comments received were favorable.

The substance of the proposed amendment having been published and for the reasons stated in the Notice, § 71.181 (27 F. R. 220-139, November 10, 1962) is amended by adding the following:

Minneapolis, Minn.

That airspace E of Minneapolis extending upward from 5,000 feet MSL bounded on the N by V-78, on the SE by V-26, and on the SW by V-2N; that airspace W of Minneapolis bounded on the N by V-78, on the SE by V-148, and on the SW by V-171; and that airspace W of Farmington, Minn., bounded on the NE by V-171, on the S by V-26, and on the NW by V-148.

This amendment shall become effective 0001 EST, November 14, 1963.
