PART 71-DESIGNATION OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS,  
CONTROLLED AIRSPACE, AND REPORTING POINTS (NEW)

Designation of Control Zone

On August 23, 1963, a Notice of Proposed Rule Making was published in the Federal Register (28 F. R. 9322) stating that the Federal Aviation Agency proposed to designate a control zone at Brainerd, Minn.

Interested persons were afforded an opportunity to participate in the rulemaking through submission of comments. All comments received were favorable.

The substance of the proposed amendment having been published and for the reasons stated in the Notice, § 71.171 (27 F. R. 220-91, November 10, 1962) is amended by adding the following:

Brainerd, Minn.

Within a 5-mile radius of the Brainerd-Crow Wing County Municipal Airport (Lat. 46° 23' 25" N, Long. 94° 08' 20" W) and within 2 miles each side of the Brainerd VOR 297° radial, extending from the 5-mile radius zone to the VOR from 0700 to 2000 hours, local time, daily.

This amendment shall become effective 0001 EST, December 12, 1963.
