Notices of parts purchased should state the specific part numbers, quantities purchased, and whether <u>future</u> amendments and special regulations are wanted.

<u>How to remit</u>: The Government Printing Office requires that <u>remittance</u> be <u>made in advance</u> of shipment of publications, either by coupons, sold in sets of 20 for \$1 and good until used, or by check or money order payable to the <u>Superintendent of Documents</u>, and sent directly to that agency. Currency may be sent at sender's risk. Postage stamps, foreign money, defaced or smooth coins are not acceptable. Deposits of \$10 or more are accepted against which orders may be placed without making individual remittances.

Postage is not required for shipment within the continental United States or its possessions. Shipments to foreign countries require an additional amount for postage of about one-third of the price of the publication. Remittances from foreign countries should be made by international money order, or draft on an American bank, payable to the Superintendent of Documents. A discount of 25 percent is allowable to book dealers and purchasers of 100 or more copies of a single publication to be mailed to one address, on condition that the purchasers will adhere to the public sales price set by the Superintendent of Documents and that publications shall not be overprinted with any advertising matter.

Note: <u>Manuals</u>, which supplement the parts of the Civil Air Regulations, <u>Regulations of the Administrator</u>, and <u>Aviation Safety Releases</u> are published by the <u>Civil Aeronautics Administration</u>, <u>U. S. Department of Commerce</u>, Washington 25, D. C.
