USDA Housing Preservation Grants Open

The *United States Department of Agriculture* (USDA) Rural Development division is <u>now accepting applications</u> for its Housing Preservation Grant program. Applications are due by 5:00 PM Local Time on July 6, 2015.

Secretary Foxx Highlights Cities Adopting Bicycle Investment to Move Beyond Traffic

The *United States Department of Transportation* (USDOT) highlighted examples of cities that are <u>investing in bicycle infrastructure</u> and seeing the benefits of those projects. Cities, particularly those part of the Secretary's Mayor's Challenge for Safer People, Safer Streets, are increasingly looking for ways to invest limited funding to reduce roadway congestion. Investing in bicycle infrastructure is a solution some communities are implementing.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released a new tool called the <u>EJSCREEN</u>. EJSCREEN is an environmental justice mapping and screening tool. The tool uses maps and reports to generate environmental indicators, demographic indicators, and environmental justice indices.
