

Vision Zero Stakeholder Involvement

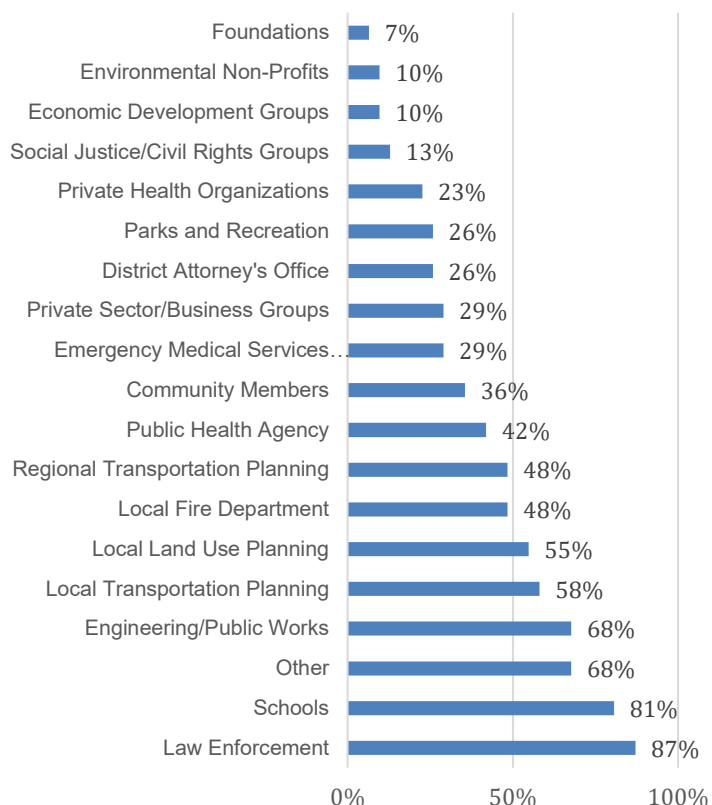
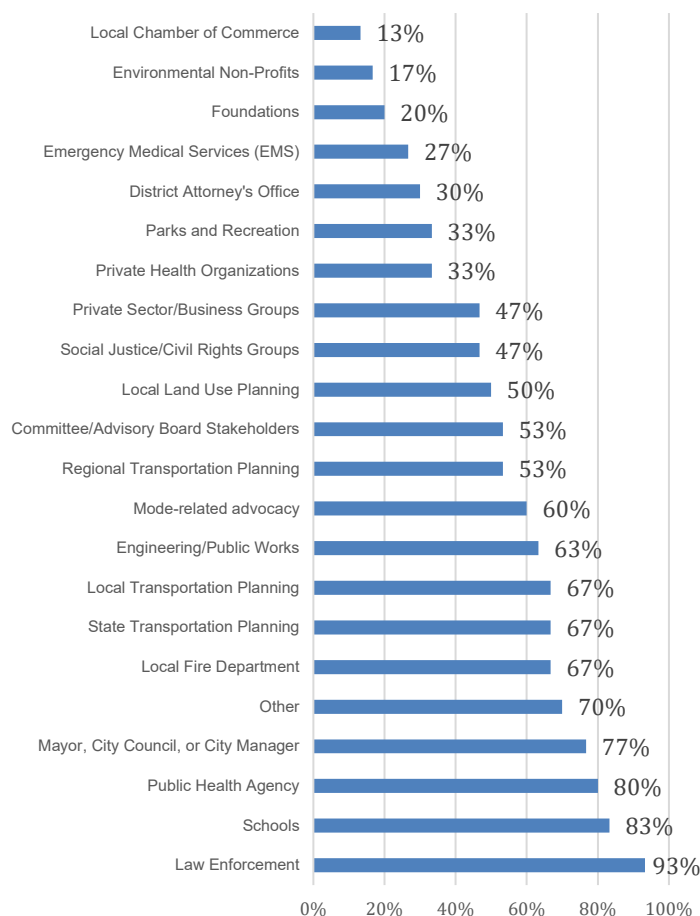
- Vision Zero aims to use a Safe System approach to reduce to zero all fatalities and serious injuries due to traffic crashes.
