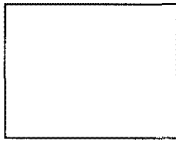

INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM INFORMATION

The International Symposium on Transportation Technology Transfer will bring together professionals and organizations from around the world to share information on best practices in technology transfer techniques. This gathering will provide a forum for open discussion of the tools of technology transfer. It is important to understand that engineering and technical topics will not be a part of the program. Please join us in a casual atmosphere to learn and share with your colleagues (resort casual attire—no ties).

Among the topics of discussion will be:

- Improving the technology of technology transfer
- Innovative training
- Sharing information resources
- Networking and twinning: partnering technology transfer centers
- Marketing and promoting your services

Program Format:

Joint sessions throughout the week will feature premier technology transfer speakers. Participating organizations will hold simultaneous meetings that are open to all attendees. Cross-participation is encouraged. While some organizations may have some translation, the official language of the Symposium will be English.

Registration Fees:

Registration fees cover program meals, breaks and social events that appear on the agenda. Spouse/guest registration includes social functions, but does not include business lunches. If paid after June 29, fees are \$350 USD for participants and \$200 USD spouse/guest.
