Subject: Deletion of reference to Washington National Airport in section 60.18-7.

The new Part 619 (25 F.R. 10343) entitled, "Special Airport Traffic Rules," was adopted on October 24, 1960, to become effective on November 29, 1960. Subpart B of Part 619 established special air traffic rules applicable to all aircraft operations within the Washington National Airport Traffic Area. On the effective date of Part 619, the provisions of section 60.18-7 will no longer be applicable to operators of aircraft taking off from or landing at the Washington National Airport.

Therefore, Supplement 60-31 (25 F.R. 10342), which was issued on October 24, 1960, amended section 60.18-7 by deleting all reference to the Washington National Airport on the effective date of the adoption of Part 619.

This supplement is issued to remove this obsolete reference from the manual.
