## Termination of Subscription Service Civil Aeronautics Manual 43

This new Part supersedes the remaining sections of Civil Aeronautics Manual 43, General Operation Rules, dated September 1959. The Special Notice dated August 31, 1962, announced that CAM 43 would be superseded by three new FAR Parts — 41, 61, and 91. However, the complete recodification is contained in FAR Part 61, issued in 1962, and Part 91 /New/. CAM 43 becomes obsolete September 30, 1963.
