Civil Aeronautics Manual 43

The Federal Aviation Agency has issued a new Part 91 — General Operating and Flight Rules, to become effective September 30, 1963. This new Part supersedes the remaining sections of Civil Aeronautics Manual 43, General Operation Rules, dated September 1959. Part 91 is available from this Office at 30 cents per copy, as indicated on the enclosed order form.

The Special Notice dated August 31, 1962, announced that CAM 43 would be superseded by three new FAR Parts — 41, 61, and 91. However, the complete recodification is contained in FAR Part 61, issued in 1962, and Part 91 New. CAM 43 becomes obsolete September 30, 1963.

Changes to Part 91 New will be sent free to those who send FAA the order form included in the front of Part 91.
