SUBJECT: Revisions to Civil Aeronautics Manual 21 dated October 15, 1956.

CAR section 21.18 requires the use of a radio compass. Due to the development of the VOR airways system, some aircraft used for instrument flight have VOR receivers with an RMI and do not have ADF/MDF radio navigation equipment. This revision authorizes the use of such VOR equipment to meet this requirement.

Aviation Safety personnel titles have been changed in accordance with Department of Commerce Notice, Amendment 13, published in 22 F. R. 989, February 16, 1957.


