SUBJECT: Revisions.

In accordance with recent Civil Air Regulations amendments, Civil Aeronautics Manuals 22, 26, 27, and 35 are revised to delete the airman identification card requirement from the Civil Air Regulations and from the related rules, policies, and interpretations of the Administrator; and to include age requirements as amended in amendments 22-12, 26-10, 27-9, and 35-3.

Civil Aeronautics Manual 33 is revised to include revised Part 33, effective November 1, 1956; and amendment 33-1 re age requirements.

Civil Aeronautics Manual 34 is revised to correct the reference "requirements of sections 34.2 through 34.6" in section 34.32-1 to read "requirements of sections 34.21, 34.22, 34.23, 34.27, and 34.31", and to include amendment 34-1 re age requirements.
