

SUBJECT: 40.1
Provision for Issuance

In accordance with the authority vested in the Administrator in the Civil Aeronautics Act of 1938 and the Civil Air Regulations, air carrier operating certificates are issued to each air carrier when all requirements for issuance have been met. In this connection, the Administrator is authorized to include specific requirements or limitations in the operating specifications which, in his opinion, are necessary for the conduct of a safe operation. These limitations are set forth in the operations specifications as preface pages which become an integral part of the air carrier operating certificate. Certain of these preface pages are standard for all air carriers operating under this part of the Civil Air Regulations. Among these, is the Aircraft Preface Page which outlines specific requirements and limitations pertaining to the aircraft which are used in the proposed operation. The purpose of this Civil Aeronautics Manual Supplement is to revise that particular page and cancel Safety Regulation Release No. 167 by issuing new instructions for completing the aircraft preface page. This revision deletes the specific requirement that cargo carried in passenger compartments must be packaged in standard mail pouches, or the equivalent and, generally, rephrases other requirements on this page for greater clarity.

40.1-1 PREFACE PAGES TO OPERATIONS SPECIFICATIONS

This supplement supersedes Safety Regulation Release No. 167. The attached new page headed "CAR 40.1 Provision for Issuance" should be retained as a page in a series of statements that will be issued explaining or implementing Civil Air Regulation 40.

"CAR 40.1 Provision for issuance. Pursuant to the provisions of the Civil Aeronautics Act of 1938, as amended, empowering the Administrator of Civil Aeronautics to issue air carrier operating certificates and the Board to establish minimum safety standards for the operation of the air carrier to whom any such certificate is issued, the following regulations are prescribed for such certification of scheduled air carriers engaged in interstate air transportation within the continental limits of the United States, as to their competency."

40.1-1 PREFACE PAGES TO OPERATIONS SPECIFICATIONS (CAA policies which apply to section 40.1).

Preface pages to the operations specifications, which are a part of the air carrier operating certificate issued by the Administrator, shall be prepared by the air carrier on a Form ACA-1014. This form is prescribed by the Administrator, and copies of it may be obtained from the Aviation Safety Agent assigned to the air carrier or from a district or regional office of the Civil Aeronautics Administration.
