SUBJECT: Revisions to CAM 3 dated October 1956 and CAM 6 dated November 1956.

This supplement is issued for the purpose of bringing the Civil Air Regulations up-to-date in the subject manuals.

Changes to the section on position light system installation and a new section concerning the anticollision light system are added to both manuals. In addition, a new section 3.705-1, anticollision light standards, is added to CAM 3. Also included in each manual is Special Civil Air Regulation No. SR-392B concerning facilitation of experiments with exterior lighting systems.

This supplement includes Amendments 3-1 and 6-1 effective April 1, 1957, and Special Civil Air Regulation No. SR-392B, effective February 25, 1957.
