The revisions delete the requirement that the center of gravity limits information be furnished the Washington office for ruling when such limits cannot be obtained practically during type tests (sec. 3.71-1 (c)), provide the pilot with a needed indication when the trim device is in the neutral position (sec. 3.337-3), assure that a new airplane will have adequate generator capacity when the airplane is equipped for IFR flight under the provisions of Part 43 (sec. 3.681-2), and permit consideration of a bottom fuselage installation for an anticollision light (sec. 3.700-3).
