SUBJECT: FINAL ANNOUNCEMENT/INVITATION TO ATTEND THE FIRST BIENNIAL
AIRWORTHINESS REVIEW CONFERENCE

This is to remind all interested persons that the First Biennial Airworthiness Review Conference will convene on December 2-11, 1974, at the Shoreham-American Hotel, 2500 Calvert Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20008. The Shoreham-American Hotel has reserved a block of rooms for attendees at special rates. Due to the expected large attendance, it is suggested that hotel reservations be made at your earliest convenience to assure lodging and accommodations. The Washington, D. The Conference has been established as a key step in the FAA's recently established program for the systematic review and updating of FAA's airworthiness regulations. The overall program was described in Notices 74-5 and 74-5A. (See Federal Register, 39 F.R. 5785 dated February 15, 1974, 39 F.R. 18662 dated May 29, 1974).

A registration fee of twenty-five dollars per attendee has been established.
